ARTS & CRAFTS

- I. Exhibit requirements – a project or a hobby
 - A. Entry form for each entry exhibited.
 - B. There are 10 categories. You may exhibit no more than one entry per category but you may exhibit in as many categories as you wish.
Kits are permitted in all categories except the Creative-do-it-yourself category, number 9.

CATEGORIES

1. Painting or sketching – this includes oil paints, water color, chalk, pencil or pen, glass, crayola, on china, wood, metal, paper, canvas, etc. Also various kinds of folk painting.
 2. Sculpturing – any article constructed from wood, clay, marble, paper, paper maché, wax, metal, etc.
 3. Needlework and Fabric decoration.
 4. Jewelry.
 5. Doll Craft – a type of doll made from any medium.
 6. Paper tole (sometimes known as 3-dimensional decoupage).
 7. Decorative flower arrangements – (of a permanent type), such as fabric, shell, paper, feathers, bump chenille, plastic, dried flower arrangement, wall hangings or centerpieces, etc.
 8. Holiday and Seasonal decorations.
 9. Creative-do-it-yourself – articles made from scraps of anything. Ideas and designs must be original.
 10. Miscellaneous Crafts – any item that does not fit into one of the above listed categories.
- II. References for information – craft stores, art shops, trash cans, fields or empty lots, fabric shops, library, dump or wreckage and salvage yards.
 - * Categories are similar to classes at County Fair. These are subject to change. See the Fairbook for new categories. Any Arts and Crafts projects not included in a Class will be entered under Miscellaneous Crafts.
