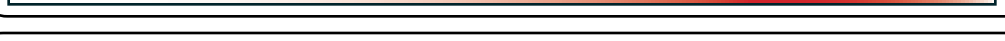
Project Timeline

Project Requirements

Poultry Project members who intend to exhibit their animal(s) at the Adams County Fair must complete the following to remain eligible for fair entry and exhibition:

1. Enroll in the Poultry Project by the enrollment deadline.
2. Complete the Meat Quality Assurance (MQA) Training annually.
3. Complete and file an Animal Care and Housing Form on 4HOnline by deadline.
4. ID all poultry in 4HOnline by June 15 deadline.
5. Attend Animal Record Book Interviews and present an up-to-date E-Record Book.
6. Enter by the Fair entry deadline.
7. Complete and turn in the Livestock Project E-Record the Friday before Labor Day to the Extension Office

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Additional Information - Animal Entry in 4hOnline

1. 4-H members are required to enter their animals in the 4-H Online enrollment system. This page will help summarize the information required in this system.
2. All poultry project animals must be entered in the 4-H Online system no later than June 15th of the current project year.
3. Poultry project members must be sure to correctly enter their poultry in the proper poultry type.
4. Options are: Chickens (Show Birds), Ducks, Geese, Pigeons & Game Birds, Breeding Chicken - Egg Production, Poultry Market Chicken, Turkey Breeding and Turkey Market.
5. It is highly recommended that any and all animals with the potential of attending Fair have ID in 4HOnline. If an animals does not have ID, it will not be allowed at Fair.

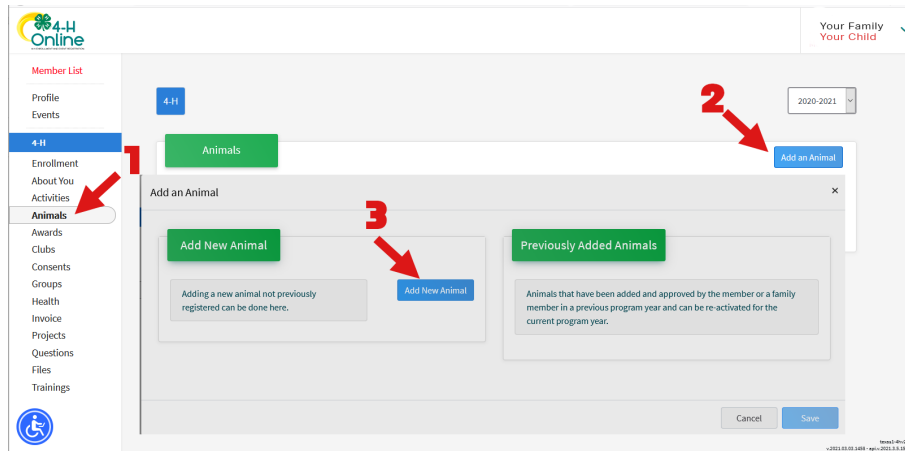

Steps for Success:

1. Sign up for 4-H Fourcast Newsletters
2. Attend club meetings & meet your club's poultry leader & other poultry members
3. Order the poultry project manuals through your Club Leader to help you learn
4. Download the Livestock E-Recordbook and the egg production supplement
5. Review Fair premium book to understand show rules and classes
6. Attend required and optional club and county workshops to learn
7. Work on Livestock E-Recordbooks regularly.
8. When in doubt, contact the 4-H office with questions
