Collectibles

There are two units in Collectibles - Basic and Advanced. You may exhibit no more than one entry per unit, however, you may exhibit in both units.

Collectibles are a group of items that are of the same type. (i.e. Coins may be all foreign or all U.S. Sports cards would all relate to the same sport.) Your collection may be of financial value or only of value to you.

Maintaining a collection may cover many areas: basic care and layout of collection, learning appropriate terminology, cataloging your collection, using certain tools, joining a club, taking a field trip, buying and selling your items, researching the history of your various items, learning the value of your collection.

If appropriate, find out if there are any laws that relate to legally maintaining your collection.

<u>Units</u>

- Unit 1. Basic Collectibles collection includes basic care, layout of collection, learning appropriate terminology.
- Unit 2. Advanced Collectibles Maintaining your collection will require more time and effort. Your collection may have to be cataloged, research may have to be done, certain tools may need to be used.

Both units are divided into three age groups:

- 1. Junior Ages 8-10
 - 2. Intermediate Ages 11-13
 - 3. Senior Ages 14-18
