# Scholarship Opportunities

## Adam Ginther Scholarship

In memory of Adam Ginther, his family and Shoco Oil are sponsoring scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$2000 to be given to graduating high school seniors who are planning to attend an accredited two-year or four-year college or vocational/technical school for the 2022/2023 academic year.

### Eligibility

1. Applicant must be an Adams County 4-H member in good standing during the 2021/2022 4-H year.
2. Minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average
3. Applicant cannot be an immediate family member of Adams County Extension employees
4. Submit application and a 500 word essay

## Adams County 4-H Scholarship Committee

### Eligibility

1. The applicant must be a current Adams County, Colorado 4-H Club member.
2. He/she must have completed at least two years of 4-H work. High school senior with sufficient credits for entrance to a college, university or trade school as a freshman. He/she may major in any field of study.
3. Applicant must show academic promise.

The Adams County 4-H Scholarship Committee (a.k.a. Foundation) has established a cash scholarship for educational assistance. The amount and number of scholarships will be determined each year by the Board of Trustees.

## 4-H Programs Scholarship

### Eligibility

1. The applicant must be a current Adams County, Colorado 4-H Club member.
2. High school senior with sufficient credits for entrance to a college, university or trade school as a freshman. He/she may major in any field of study.
3. This scholarship is open to any Adams County 4-H member who has exhibited a 4-H project at the Adams County Fair the year immediately prior to applying for scholarship.

The scholarship will not exceed \$1000.00; however may be less at the discretion of the selection committee.

Once the scholarship has been awarded; the applicant cannot reapply for an additional scholarship.

The scholarship is to be utilized for any educational opportunity.

## Horse Committee Scholarship

### Eligibility

1. The applicant must be a current Adams County, Colorado 4-H Club member.
2. High school senior with sufficient credits for entrance to a college, university or trade school as a freshman. He/she may major in any field of study.
3. This scholarship is open to any Adams County 4-H member who has exhibited a 4-H Horse project at the Adams County Fair the year immediately prior to applying for scholarship.

The scholarship will not exceed \$500.00 per applicant; however may be less.

Once the scholarship has been awarded; the applicant cannot reapply for an additional scholarship.

The scholarship is to be utilized for any educational opportunity.

## Adams County Junior Livestock Sale

### Eligibility

1. The applicant must have completed at least one semester at any accredited University, College or Trade School and must be currently enrolled.
2. Major of study can be in any field.
3. Applicant must show academic promise.
4. Applicant must apply for the scholarship within six-years of their last 4-H enrollment

This scholarship is open to any Adams County 4-H or FFA member who has sold an animal in the Adams County Jr. Livestock Sale for a minimum of two years.

The scholarship will not exceed \$500.00 per applicant; however may be less at the discretion of the Sale Committee.

Once the scholarship has been awarded; the applicant cannot reapply for an additional scholarship.

The scholarship is to be utilized for any educational opportunity.

## Additional Information

1. Applicant must submit online application form by May 1st - <http://goo.gl/forms/p9rhNUCOaE>
2. Applicant must submit an official transcript of the most recent year's grades.
3. Applicant must submit a photo including head and shoulders, no smaller than 2"x 3"
4. Applicant must have two short recommendation letters.  
(May be from a principal, counselor, teacher, minister, 4-H Leader, etc.)
